On May 13, 2009, AT&T Tennessee declared a force majeure event due to severe storm damage caused by the unusually heavy rain and flooding beginning May 10 pursuant to Section 4.5.2 of AT&T Tennessee's Self Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms Administration Plan ("Plan"). We are pleased to report that restoration efforts have progressed sufficiently to remove some wire centers from the force majeure declaration effective May 23, 2011. Those wire centers are listed in the attachment.

The remaining Tennessee wire centers will remain in the force majeure declaration for the immediate future, but we will notify you when they, too, have been removed.
