
Dear Chairman Kyle:

Time Warner Cable Information Services (Tennessee), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable (“TWCIS”), pursuant to TRA Rule 1220-4-8-.05, hereby notifies the Authority of its surrender of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”) granted to it by the Authority on December 23, 2004, in the above-referenced proceeding.

Due to changed circumstances and changes in its business plans, TWCIS does not intend to begin providing service in Tennessee pursuant to the authority granted to it in this Certificate. TWCIS therefore is surrendering its Certificate pursuant to this notice. TWCIS does not provide – and to date has not marketed – telecommunications service to any customer in Tennessee, and has no operative tariff on file with the Authority. As a result, TWCIS’s surrender of the Certificate will not affect any customer.
