TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**



This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 6, 2006. Time Warner Cable Information Services (Tennessee) LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee on June 16, 2004. During a Hearing held on October 12, 2004, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On September 5, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
