



**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 7, 2012. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services in Tennessee, including exchange access services, was filed by Quality Telephone, Inc. (the "Company") on July 21, 2004. During a Hearing held on October 14, 2004, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 2, 2012, the Authority received a request to cancel the Company's CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
