ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE POST-ARGUMENT BRIEFS

This docket is before the Hearing Officer to consider the request of the parties to extend the time for filing post-argument briefs. On March 4, 2005, the parties filed a letter requesting an extension until Friday, March 11, 2005 to file their briefs. The parties explain they may be close to a settlement.

The Hearing Officer finds that the basis stated for the extension constitutes good cause and that an extension will not unnecessarily delay this docket. Based on these findings and the fact that the request is unopposed, the Hearing Officer concludes that the request should be granted.

The parties shall be granted an extension until **Friday, March 11, 2005** to file their post-argument briefs.
