
ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice-Chair David F. Jones, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner David Crowell, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or the “Commission”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on February 20, 2024. On December 1, 2004, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting Telecom Management, Inc. d/b/a Pioneer Telephone (“Telecom Management” or “Company”) a CCN to provide operator services and/or resell interexchange services.¹ On November 30, 2023, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN because it has neither active operations nor customers in Tennessee. The Company is in good standing with the Commission concerning payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its CCN.
