

Code Ann. § 65-4-107 *et seq.*, a hearing has been scheduled in the above-captioned matter for **Monday, November 22, 2004 at 1:00 p.m.** in the Hearing Room on the Ground Floor at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Tennessee Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-101 *et seq.* Chairman Pat Miller, Director Deborah Taylor Tate, and Director Ron Jones, the voting panel assigned to this docket, will conduct the hearing. All parties are entitled to be represented by counsel.

The hearing is scheduled for the purpose of hearing testimony regarding Atmos Energy Corporation's requests for approval of franchise agreements with Columbia, Tennessee. Atmos Energy Corporation is hereby directed to file pre-filed testimony of all witnesses who will testify regarding the requests for approval of the franchise agreements.
