ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES



This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 16, 2006. CI<sup>2</sup>, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services, including exchange access services, in Tennessee on October 13, 2004. During a Hearing held on May 3, 2005, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.57, which was promulgated pursuant to, *inter alia*, Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-2-102 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201, and approved the Application. On September 13, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel the Company's CCN.
