ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the filing of the *Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice* (the "*Application*") filed on August 3, 2005 by William Lee Magness, an attorney appearing on behalf of Competitive Carriers of the South, Inc. ("CompSouth").


Mr. Magness' *Application* states that he is licensed and in good standing in the State of Texas and that no disciplinary actions or investigations of his conduct are pending against him.¹ Mr. Magness agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any matter arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

This *Application* complies with Rule 19, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the *Application* by William Lee Magness for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is granted.
