ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the filing of the *Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice* (the "*Application*") filed on September 12, 2005, by Nannette Edwards, an attorney appearing on behalf of ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. ("DeltaCom"). The Hearing Officer considered the *Application* at the outset of the Hearing on the merits of the docket, which began September 13, 2005.

Ms. Edwards' *Application* states that she is licensed and in good standing in the State of South Carolina and that no disciplinary actions or investigations of her conduct are pending against her.¹ Ms. Edwards agrees to subject herself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any matter arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.


The Hearing Officer found that the *Application* complies with Rule 19, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the
