**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

---

This matter came before Chair Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on October 14, 2019. United American Technology, Inc. (“United” or the “Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on March 7, 2005 in Docket No. 04-00400.

The last inspection fee from United American Technology, Inc. for the 2015 inspection fee period was received six months late on September 28, 2016. TPUC received a handwritten letter mailed on May 15, 2017 indicating that Company is no longer doing business in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record

in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to cancel the Company's authority for failure to pay its inspection fees.
