Dear Mr. Hickerson:


At the June 27, 2005 Authority Conference, the Panel voted to convene a contested case in the above two dockets and appoint a Hearing Officer for the purpose of entering a protective order to facilitate the provision to TRA Staff information considered confidential by the Company. A protective order was filed with the Authority on July 5, 2005. Accordingly, pursuant to this protective order, we are requesting that you provide the following information. Please file an original plus one copy addressed to the Chairman's Office by July 18, 2005.

1. Un-redacted copies of Sequent Energy Management's ("Sequent") invoices for gas purchases charged to Chattanooga Gas ("CGC") for the period July 2003 through June 2004.
2. Copies of all asset management agreements between Sequent and CGC since the establishment of CGC's incentive plan.
3. Copies of all Gas Purchase and Sales Agreements between Sequent and CGC since the establishment of CGC's incentive plan.

To ensure that Staff has sufficient time to review the above documents and complete its audit of CGC's ACA and IPA filings, we request that the Company agree to another extension of the 180-day audit review period (as provided for in the Authority's Rule 1220-4-7-.03(2)) from the current August 22 deadline to the Authority Conference scheduled for September 26, 2005. Please respond in writing referencing both dockets to evidence your agreement.
