**ORDER REVOKING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COCOT SERVICES
IN TENNESSEE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF FEES**

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 15, 2008 to revoke the authority of Universal Networking and Communications Solutions, Inc. (the "Company") to offer Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service in Tennessee due to non-payment of fees.

The Company originally filed an Application to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee on November 23, 2004. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 13, 2004, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004), every owner or operator of a public pay telephone shall submit to the TRA an annual inspection and supervision fee for each service location on or before July 1 of each year. The Company was notified by mail on April 7, 2008,

July 16, 2008, August 15, 2008 and October 7, 2008 of its failure to comply with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004). A Notice of Cancellation was mailed on November 20, 2008 via certified mail. The Company failed to respond. As a result of that failure, this matter was placed on the December 15, 2008 Authority Conference for the panel to consider revocation of the Company's authority to provide COCOT service due to non-payment of fees.


Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to revoke the authority of the Company to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


