Per Consolidated Utility District's Board of Commissioners' action of August 29, 2000, a bond must be posted in the amount of \$1,000 per lot with a minimum of \$50,000. The bond must be held for 18 months after construction and upon CUD accepting the system.

Union County does not require any type of bond before a wastewater utility can construct or operate within Union County. I hope this answers the question listed in your letter dated March 30, 2005.


