ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Director Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 24, 2010. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local exchange service, including exchange access telecommunications services, in Tennessee was filed by CommPartners, LLC (the "Company") on February 10, 2005. During a Hearing held on December 8, 2005, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 14, 2010, the Company requested that the Authority cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
