Nashville Gas Company ("Nashville Gas"), a division of Piedmont Natural Gas Company, respectfully moves for an extension of time of seven (7) days, from January 20, 2006 to Friday, January 27, 2006, to file its Discovery Responses and Objections to TRA Staff's Second Round of Discovery Requests. As grounds for this Motion, Nashville Gas submits the following.

- On November 28, 2005, the TRA issued its Order Establishing Procedural Schedule in this matter. Per the Order, the second round of discovery requests was due on January 3, 2006
- On January 3, 2006, TRA Staff served its Second Discovery Requests on counsel for Nashville Gas by mail TRA Staff mailed the discovery requests to the prior address of Nashville Gas' counsel As a result, Nashville Gas did not receive the discovery requests until Monday, January 9, 2006
- Due to this delay, Nashville Gas requires additional time to prepare and serve its Responses and Objections to TRA Staff's Second Round of Discovery Requests

 Counsel for TRA Staff has indicated that TRA Staff has no objection to Nashville Gas' request for an extension of time
