


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 8, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by vCustomer Corporation (the "Company") on June 24, 2005. During a Hearing held on August 8, 2005, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On November 14, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


