**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

This matter came before Chairman Ron Jones, Director Deborah Taylor Tate and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 12, 2005 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and Telepak, Inc.¹ filed on July 7, 2005.²

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement and Amendment Thereto* issued on July 5, 2005 in Docket No 05-00100 and unanimously granted the Petition.
