**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**



This matter came before Director Kenneth C. Hill, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 11, 2011. DelTel, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on August 4, 2005. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 21, 2006, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application.<sup>1</sup> On June 27, 2011, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.<sup>2</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
