JOINT ISSUES MATRIX

- 2. Whether LTD Holding Company, after becoming the parent company of United Telephone-Southeast, Inc., LTD Long Distance and Sprint Payphone Services, Inc., will have the financial ability and managerial and technical capability to efficiently perform the utility services that are being transferred to it, and

3. Whether it is appropriate for the Authority to place any conditions on LTD holding Company and its Tennessee subsidiaries as outlined on pages 23 and 24 of the confidential prefiled direct testimony of Debbie Goldman, and if so, what conditions should the Authority place on LTD holding Company and its Tennessee subsidiaries.
