Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI") hereby provides notice of its intent to provide wastewater service to the Stoney Brook subdivision located at 8411 Highway 25 East, Cross Plains, Robertson County, Tennessee pursuant to T.C.A. 65-4-201.


The Commission granted TWSI a CCN in Docket 95-00293 to provide service to certain areas of Cross Plains, Tennessee. The Stoney Brook subdivision is a parcel that adjoins TWSI's pipeline to the north and the treatment facility property to the south, however it was not included in the original service territory. The treatment facility was built and put into operation in 2005 and has sufficient capacity to serve the 19 lots in Stoney Brook.

Enclosed with this notice is a revised map of the Cross Plains service territory including the Stoney Brook property and denial of service letters from the Robertson County mayor and the White House Utility District.
