

Dear Chairman Roberson:

Recently, Texas counsel representing dPi Teleconnect, LLC served Interrogatories on BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee. This is to notify the Authority that AT&T Tennessee does not intend to respond to the Interrogatories because they were propounded in violation of the Rules of the Authority. Specifically, Authority Rule 1220-1-2-.11 provides that any party to a contested case may *petition* for discovery. The Rule further provides that "...where discovery is sought, ***no discovery shall be undertaken*** until a discovery schedule is set in accordance with these rules." (Emphasis added.) Counsel for dPi has neither petitioned for discovery nor sought a procedural schedule in this docket.


