ORDER HOLDING DOCKET IN ABEYANCE

On November 28, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") filed a letter requesting that the proceedings in this matter be held in abeyance in Tennessee, while similar cases proceed to hearing in other former BellSouth states.


On December 21, 2007 dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C. ("dPi") filed its *Second Set of Requests for Information*. On January 9, 2008, BellSouth filed a letter indicating that it did not intend to respond to dPi's interrogatories, as they were issued outside of a procedural schedule. Further, BellSouth renewed its request to hold this proceeding in abeyance while hearings proceed in other states.

On January 23, 2008, this Hearing Officer was notified that the parties are in agreement that this matter should be held in abeyance and that no status conference is requested at this time. (See attached email dated January 23, 2008).

The Hearing Officer finds that the parties' agreement and request to hold this docket in abeyance is well-taken and should be granted.
