**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chair Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on October 14, 2019. NECC Telecom, Inc. (“NECC” or the “Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on March 10, 2006 in Docket No. 05-00332.

The last inspection fee from NECC for the 2015 inspection fee period was received on April 1, 2016. Since 2016, all annual inspection fee letters have been returned to the Commission and all attempts to contact the company via certified mail, phone, and email have gone unacknowledged. Based upon careful consideration of the

entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to cancel the Company's authority for failure to pay its inspection fees.
