

ORDER ACCEPTING WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION

On September 11, 2006, Cartwright Creek, L.L.C. ("Cartwright Creek") informed the Tennessee Regulatory Authority that it is withdrawing its *Petition* to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity to expand its service area to include the Burrus Ridge Development in Robertson County, Tennessee filed on January 10, 2006. Cartwright Creek indicates that the developer of Burrus Ridge has made arrangements with the City of White House to provide wastewater service to the development

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The request of Cartwright Creek, L.L.C. to withdraw its *Petition* to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity to expand its service area to include the Burrus Ridge Development in Robertson County, Tennessee is granted and this docket is closed.
