#### INDIRECT TRANSFER OF CONTROL

TACO has reached an agreement with the Sellers whereby TACO will acquire all of the membership interest of the sellers, subject to certain regulatory approvals. Specifically, TACO agrees to purchase and redeem 100% of the equity membership interests of the Sellers. Under this Agreement, Seller agrees to sell, assign, transfer, and deliver to Purchaser, all their equity membership interests at the Closing. BCN is and will continue to be solely owned by TACO before and after the transaction.

#### QUALIFICATIONS OF TRANSFEREE

Richard Boudria organized BCN Telecom, Inc., f/k/a NUI Telecom, Inc., f/k/a International Telephone Group, Inc. on April 14, 1994. The Company flourished for many years due to Mr. Boudria's dedication to quality and service. In April 2000, Mr. Boudria sold the Company to NUI Capital Corp. On May 21, 2003, Mr. Boudria organized TACO to repurchase the Company. Mr. Boudria currently owns 13% equity membership interest in TACO. Upon consummation of this transaction Mr. Boudria will be the majority equity membership owner of TACO. Mr. Boudria is and will remain the President and CEO of BCN. TACO is a privately held limited liability company financially qualified to control the Company and its business. A copy of TACO's balance sheet is attached as Exhibit B.


