CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Authority in its review of VCI Company's application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competing facilities-based and resold local telecommunications services in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following information:

- 1 A complete list of complaints filed with state and federal regulatory agencies within the past year, a description of the complaint and an explanation of how the complaint was resolved
- 2 Further information regarding the two (2) officers and their specific technical and managerial experience in the telecommunications industry, detailing job responsibilities, etc. If there will be other individuals working for this company in a managerial capacity, please provide information regarding their specific experience in the telecommunications industry
- 3 A sample VCI Company bill
- 4 Regarding the notice of filing that is required to be served on all eighteen ILECs in Tennessee, your Exhibit L states that, "I certify that a copy of this Notice has been served upon the following carriers via US mail." However, there was no language in this notice to explain to the ILECs that an application to provide competing local service had been filed by VCI Company. Was there a page left out of the exhibit that contained the language informing the ILECs of this filing?
