ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 12, 2007. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by NationsLine South, Inc. (the "Company") on January 25, 2006. During a Hearing held on March 30, 2006, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On February 5, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
