

RE: Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc.'s Petition to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Wastewater Utility Services (Docket No. 06-00021)

Dear Mr. Pickney:

Applicants for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Authority in its review of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc.'s ("TWS") amendment to its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide wastewater utility services to the portion of Jefferson County, Tennessee, known as Keene's Island, you are requested to provide the following information:

- 1. The number of residential customers to be served and the number of commercial customers to be served by the wastewater system.
- 2. What is the estimated total cost to construct the wastewater system?
- 3. Of the \$60,000 estimated value of the contribution in aid of construction, how much is attributable to the appraised or estimated value of the permanent easement of the property on which the wastewater system will occupy?
- 4. Who will be the developer(s) and the entity(s) that will build and pay for construction of the system and transfer ownership of the system to TWS? Provide the name(s) and address.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 22, 2006 and that you reference Docket No. 06-00021 on your response. In accordance with Authority rules, submit either thirteen (13) written copies of your response or four (4) written copies and an electronic version.
