Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. provides the following information per your request dated March 15, 2005.

1. The number of residential customers to be served and the number of commercial customers to be served by the wastewater system.

Response: We estimate that 50% of the customers will be residential.

2. What is the estimated total cost to construct the wastewater system?

Response: The estimated total cost to construct the system is \$175,000.

3. Of the \$175,000 estimated value of the contribution in aid of construction, how much is attributable to the appraised or estimated value of the permanent easement of the property on which the wastewater system will occupy?
