**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison, Director Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017. OneTone Telecom, Inc. ("OneTone" or the "Company") filed an Application for authority to resell local and interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee on January 27, 2006. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 3, 2006, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On October 14, 2016, the Authority received a request from OneTone to cancel its authority. The Company stated that it is no longer doing business in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.¹
