


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Tre Hargett, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 21, 2008. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services, within the State of Tennessee was filed by Symtelco, LLC (the "Company") on February 8, 2006. During a Hearing held on April 13, 2006, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On February 25, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.


