**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENTS
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**


This matter came before Chairman Ron Jones, Director Pat Miller and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 3, 2006 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendments to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and Covista, Inc. filed on February 10, 2006.¹

Based upon a review of the amendments, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on December 1, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00278 and unanimously granted the Petition.
