

I spoke with John Manning. He confirmed that a company must meet the months to exhaust and utilization criteria for the rate center into which they would like to move a prefix. There also must be no ported numbers out of that prefix prior to the move. If the TRA were to issue an order approving the move of that prefix from one rate center to another, even if the carrier did not in 2008 meet the NANPA's requirements, then NANPA would allow the move. The carrier must submit the order with the request to move the prefix when they submit that request in 2008. NANPA will not keep the order on file in anticipation of the move two years down the road. Of course, who knows what new rules might be put into place in two years to negate what I say in this email, but under current rules I think there are no problems. Thanks
