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AMENDED PETITION FOR 2-1-1 DIALING CODE

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United Way of Metropolitan Nashville (UWMN) respectfully submits this Amended Petition for allocation of an N11 number for the purpose of providing health and human service information & referral. In the previous petition, submitted February 14, 2006, UWMN requested allocation of the 2-1-1 dialing code in Hancock County. UWMN has since learned that Scott County Telephone Cooperative (SCTC) has already activated 2-1-1 and is currently sending 2-1-1 calls to the Department of Human Services in Virginia. Further, SCTC did not support the plan to send calls from 65 SCTC customers in Hancock County, TN, to our call center in Nashville, TN. Doug Fluegel, 2-1-1 State Director, spoke with Daniel Odom, CFO at SCTC, and both parties agreed that the best call center to handle the 2-1-1 calls from Hancock County is the Kingsport 2-1-1 call center run by Contact-Concern of Northeast Tennessee (CCNT). CCNT has filed a petition requesting the 2-1-1 dialing code in Hancock County and UWMN hereby withdraws its petition for designation of the 2-1-1 dialing code in Hancock County in support of assigning the 2-1-1 dialing code to CCNT.
