## ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chair Robin L. Morrison, Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner David F. Jones of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on July 23, 2018. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing facilities-based local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by Vo2 Networx, Inc. a/k/a Business Communications, Inc. (the "Company") on February 22, 2006. During a Hearing held on May 4, 2006, the Hearing Officer found that Vo2 Networx, Inc. had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On July 3, 2018, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN. The Company no longer has a physical presence in Tennessee, and has no intentions of providing competing resold and facilities-based local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within Tennessee in the future. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
