ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones, and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 9, 2016. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including exchange access telecommunications services, and facilities-based and resold exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by LMDS Holdings, Inc. on March 10, 2006 and amended on June 26, 2006 to reflect a name change to Nextlink Wireless, Inc. ("Nextlink" or the "Company").¹ During a Hearing held on August 24, 2006, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On March 4, 2016, the Authority received a request from Nextlink to cancel its CCN, stating that it has no customers in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
