Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. provides the following information per your request dated April 21, 2006.

1. Please provide the number of commercial customers and the number of residential customers to be served by the wastewater system in this docket.

Response: We estimate that 50% of the customers will be residential.

2. Provide a sworn pre-filed direct testimony. This testimony should describe the services to be provided, the applicant's technical, managerial, and financial abilities to provide the services; the public need for the service; a statement that Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. agrees to comply with all Tennessee Regulatory policies, rules and regulations; and a notarized affidavit affirming that all information submitted is true and correct.

Response: Please see the attached, revised Pre-filed Testimony.

3. Identify all complaints filed with any state agency involving your company or affiliated entities. Identify the nature of the complaint, the government agency or office receiving the complaint and how was the complaint resolved.

Response: During the last twelve months we have not received any written complaints from the Tennessee Regulatory Authority. While we have on-going correspondence with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation concerning permit limits, appeals, etc., I would not classify that type of correspondence as a complaint.
