

RE: Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc.'s Petition to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Wastewater Utility Services (Docket No. 06-000104).

Dear Mr. Pickney:

In order for the Authority to complete its review of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc.'s ("TWS") amendment to its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide wastewater utility services to a portion of Sevier County known as Happy Creek, you are requested to provide the following additional, clarifying information. Responses should be be complete and precise, using all information that is available to you.

- 1. Please provide the number of commercial customers and the number of residential customers to be served by the wastewater system in this docket.
- 2. Provide a sworn pre-filed direct testimony. This testimony should describe the services to be provided, the applicant's technical, managerial, and financial abilities to provide the services; the public need for the service; a statement that Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. agrees to comply with all Tennessee Regulatory Authority policies, rules and regulations; and a notarized affidavit affirming that all information submitted is true and correct.
- 3. Identify all complaints filed with any state regulatory agency involving your company or affiliated entities. Identify the nature of the complaint, the government agency or office receiving the complaint and how was the complaint resolved.
- 4. Please provide a letter from the City of Sevierville of its intention to not supply wastewater service to Happy Creek.
- 5. Please provide a letter from the East Sevier County Utility District of its intention to not supply wastewater to Happy Creek.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, April 27, 2006 and you reference Docket No. 06-00104 on the response. In accordance with TRA rules, submit either one original and thirteen (13) written copies of your response or four (4) written copies and an electronic version.
