Dear Mr. Gothard:

On November 20, 2006, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“Authority” or “TRA”) issued a data request seeking, among other information, signed verifications from the parties for the *Amended Application* submitted on November 6, 2007 in the above-referenced docket. This request stemmed from the Authority’s observation that the Asset Purchase Agreement, attached as Exhibit A to the *Amended Application*, was not signed by either W2Com or Reduced Rate Long Distance. To-date, the TRA has received no response to its November 20, 2006 data request.

In addition, the Authority is aware of the Petitioners’ Section 214 transfer filing made with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) in WC Docket No. 06-110. It is our understanding that the FCC has taken no action concerning the Section 214 filing, although it was filed over a year ago. In evaluating transfers of authority, such as the one requested by the Petitioners, the TRA typically conditions its approval upon the FCC’s approval of the transfer.

Inasmuch as there has been no activity in this docket for several months, you are requested to advise the Authority of any reason why this docket should remain open. In your response, please include a description of the status of the Petitioner’s FCC Section 214 transfer filing. Please respond within ten days of the date of this correspondence.
