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
ORDER DISMISSING THE JOINT APPLICATION AND CLOSING DOCKET

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
This matter came before Director Pat Miller, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 10, 2007 to consider dismissal of the *Joint Application* filed by W2Com International, LLC ("W2Com") and Reduced Rate Long Distance, LLC (the "Applicants").

On November 20, 2006, a data request was issued by the TRA requesting signed verifications concerning contracts governing the transfer and modifications to the customer notification letter in order to bring the letter into compliance with TRA rules. No response was received to the November 20, 2006 data request. On June 29, 2007, a letter was issued asking for a reason for keeping this proceeding open given the lack of response to the November 20, 2006 data request. This letter also inquired about the status of the Applicant's Domestic Section 214 Application filed with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC").<sup>1</sup> No response was received to the June 29, 2007 letter. Based on the foregoing, the panel voted unanimously to dismiss the application without prejudice.


