ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 7, 2006 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between Citizens Telecommunications Company of the Volunteer State, LLC d/b/a Frontier Communications of the Volunteer State and Charter Fiberlink-Tennessee, LLC filed on June 30, 2006.¹

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on August 2, 2006 in Docket No. 06-00123 and unanimously granted the Petition.
