The parties have mutually agreed to proposed changes in the scheduling order. ¹ As explained at the August 23, 2006 status conference, understanding the time constraints with moving the hearing from November 28-30 to December 5-8, Chattanooga Gas Company ("CGC") agrees not to implement its requested rates prior to January 8, 2007, if the Authority has not issued a ruling. *See* Transcript of Aug. 23, 2006 Proceeding, Docket 06-00175, at 23-24. If the parties reach a settlement, CGC, however, reserves its right to implement its requested rates on January 1, 2007, if the Authority has not issued a ruling. *Id.*

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
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
