Chattanooga Gas Company has agreed to a change proposed by the Consumer Advocate. The second paragraph of tariff sheet number 38 says, "The Company reserves the right to require daily balancing, and shall have the right to curtail service to ensure deliveries on a uniform basis and to correct any imbalances." The following sentence should be added: "The Company shall show the reason for any such requirement for daily balancing or curtailments of service upon request of any affected customer or any regulatory agency."
