This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Pat Miller, and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, on January 23, 2007 for consideration of the *Petition* filed by Aqua Utilities Company ("Aqua Utilities" or the "Company") on July 19, 2006 for approval of an adjustment of its rates and charges.

Upon the request of counsel for Aqua Utilities, J. Gilbert Parrish, Jr., the panel deferred action on this matter until the next regularly scheduled Authority Conference set for February 5, 2007.
