## ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 6, 2006 for consideration of the Complaint filed on September 1, 2006 by Excelsior Communications Services, Inc. on behalf of Hilton Suites Brentwood. On October 3, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. Response to September 1, 2006 Filing Regarding Hilton Suites Brentwood.
