ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Affidavit for Permission to Practice Pro Hac Vice* filed by John Paul Walters, attorney for Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a Cingular Wireless. The *Affidavit* was filed on May 1, 2007.

Mr. Walters' *Affidavit* states that he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in the State of Oklahoma, Texas, and Missouri, and that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.¹ Mr. Walters agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any manner arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

This *Affidavit* complies with Rule 19, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the application by John Paul Walters for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is granted.
