
This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice* filed by Elaine D. Critides, attorney for Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless. The Application was filed on March 16, 2007.

Ms. Critides' Application states that she is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in the State of Maryland, and that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against her.<sup>1</sup> Ms. Critides agrees to subject herself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any manner arising out of her conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

This Application complies with Rule 19, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the Application by Elaine D. Critides for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is granted.
