ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 26, 2007 for consideration of the *Petition of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. to Amend Its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Correct the Rate Structure for Commercial Resort Properties* filed on October 10, 2006. Based on the rate increase that could result from the proposed reclassification and the concerns expressed by the affected community, the panel voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or his designee to serve as Hearing Officer for the purpose of hearing preliminary matters, setting a procedural schedule to completion and preparing the matter for a hearing before the panel.
