Dear Board Members,

I am a cabin owner in Smoky Cove, Sevierville, Tennessee. I am writing to you to protest the reclassification of cabins from a residential rate to a commercial rate.

The Pigeon Forge / Sevierville area has been known as a resort area for many years. Why has Smoky Cove just been redefined as a commercial development?

Realistically, these cabins, though rented, are used less frequently than a residence. Last year, my cabin was rented 295 days, including owner stay, compared to 365 days at a residence.

This rate increase seems far too high—more than double the amount of previous charges. Our local city service includes city water, sewer, and trash pickup for under \$50.

This rate increase will encourage us, as homeowners, to seek city service or private septic tanks for sewer disposal.

Please reconsider your position on this matter.
